

Frequently Asked Questions

Together Fund Phase 4

Q: When is the deadline for submitting applications for phase 4?

A: There is no submission deadline because the panel review applications every 2 weeks on a rolling basis. However all approved projects must be delivered **by March 2023** so please take this into consideration in relation to your project timescales.

Q: I applied for funding in phase 3 and want to apply for top-up funding. Is this possible?

A: Yes, providing your overall total for any phase does not exceed £10,000.

Q: My project has already received £10,000 but we want to apply again. What options are available for us?

A: Projects who've already received £10,000 cannot apply for the Together Fund, however we'll do what we can to signpost you to other funding opportunities where available. Please email imogen@greatersport.co.uk to discuss.

Q: I've never submitted a funding application before. Is there any support for this?

A: Yes, we have an application guidance document on the website that includes an example budget breakdown and gives you further prompts that may help when answering the key questions.

Q: Does the application have to be submitted via a document?

A: No, applications can be submitted in the following formats – word document, email, video, or voice recording. Please ensure you answer all the key questions outlined on the application form and send your completed application to imogen@greatersport.co.uk

Q: Our organisation/community group doesn't have a bank account. Can I still apply?

A: Yes! Please make this clear in your application or get in touch and we'll find the right avenue for support.

Q: My project doesn't focus on the priority groups. Can I still apply?
